



Terms and Conditions of Use:

1. You recognise the high risk of injury involved with participation in the various activities undertaken at The Boardwalk Rink. By entering The Boardwalk Rink, or consenting for a child to enter you are agreeing to participate at your own risk.
2. You agree to waive all liability claims against Boardwalk Foundation CIC t/a The Boardwalk Rink its subsidiaries and associated companies, its directors, employees and volunteers for any injuries, ailments or other damage to yourself whilst using The Boardwalk other than due to our proven negligence.
3. By signing the disclaimer form you confirm that you have no pre-existing medical conditions that may be aggravated by participating in the activities at The Boardwalk. Including but not limited to, pregnancy, high blood pressure, epilepsy, back problems, neck problems or any heart condition.

MEMBERSHIP FORMS / DISCLAIMERS

4. The Boardwalk is a Members only establishment. A relevant Membership form and Disclaimer Notice must be completed before you are permitted to use the roller rink facilities.
5. Standard Membership is free of charge and continuous.
6. All members must display their Membership card to prove that a disclaimer has been completed and to gain entry.

SAFETY EQUIPMENT POLICY

7. The Boardwalk Rink strongly recommends that ALL participants wear protective Wrist Guards when skating. **Wrist Guards are compulsory for those aged 15 and under. Participants aged 16 and over MAY opt out of wearing Wrist Guards but accept that they do so at their own risk.**
8. **Participants aged 15 and under:** It is compulsory to wear Wrist Guards at all times whilst using The Boardwalk. Participants must have a disclaimer form signed by a parent, guardian or responsible adult.
9. **Participants aged 16 and over:** You may complete your own participant disclaimer. Should you wish to opt out of wearing Wrist Guards you MUST sign a separate disclaimer further indemnifying Boardwalk Foundation CIC t/a The Boardwalk Rink and its subsidiary and associated companies, its directors, employees and volunteers for any injuries, ailments or other damage to yourself whilst using The Boardwalk other than due to our proven negligence.
10. All participants must wear suitable clothing for skating and clothing must be properly secured. No tying of jumpers, hoodies, jackets etc around your waist or shoulders.
11. Socks must be worn when renting hire skates.
12. Customer equipment brought to the Rink must be in good, safe working order and fit for purpose. No missing wheels or sharp edges. Boardwalk Foundation CIC t/a The Boardwalk its subsidiaries and



associated companies, its directors, employees and volunteers accept no liability for damage to or injury caused by customers own equipment.

CONDUCT AND RINK USAGE

13. NO SKATING IN ANY PUBLIC AREAS – INCLUDING THE CONCOURSE & THE MALL.
14. All skaters must skate in the same direction & keep moving when on the main concourse of the rink.
15. Skate to your own ability and ask Rink Staff for help when required. You should not attempt to perform manoeuvres that are beyond your skill level.
16. In the interest of safety and hygiene NO food or drink should be brought onto the Rink surface. This includes bags which contain food or drink. Food and drink may be consumed in the designated seating and viewing area(s).
17. Skates only on the rink – no shoes, with the exception of Boardwalk Rink staff. Parents/Guardians/Spectators should refrain from entering the rink arena. If assistance is required alert Rink Staff.
18. Children under the age of 10 must have a parent or responsible adult in the building at all times. Under no circumstances are children 10 and under to be dropped off and left unattended.
19. Smoking or Vaping will not be permitted inside or at the entrance and exits of The Boardwalk.
20. Abusive, discourteous or otherwise anti-social behaviour in or around The Boardwalk will not be tolerated.
21. Littering, vandalism or unauthorised graffiti will not be tolerated anywhere in or around The Boardwalk.
22. You agree not to use The Boardwalk whilst under the influence of drugs or alcohol.
23. You agree to abide by instructions given by The Boardwalk supervisors, staff and stewards at all times.
24. Payment must be made prior to participating in any session. Non-payment will be treated as theft.
25. Sessions begin & end on the allotted session time. No discount will be given when joining a session already in progress or leaving a session early.
26. No cash refunds will be made for those leaving a session prematurely.
27. The Boardwalk assumes no responsibility for the damage, loss or theft of any personal belongings brought into the Rink. Personal items should not be left unattended anywhere in or around the Rink. Lockers are available to hire.
28. Failure to abide by these generally accepted terms and conditions or to falsify consent information will result in a refusal of entry. The management reserve the right to refuse entry at any point and to change the terms and conditions of entry.
